

# **Mister and Miss Onion Day Contestant Agreement**

**Purpose:** The Miss and Mister Onion Days contest is a fundraising event for the Wolf Lake Onion Days Festival Committee. Contestants collect money on behalf of the Wolf Lake Onion Days Committee. All funds collected for the contest belongs to the Wolf Lake Onion Days Committee.

A Penny-A-Vote system will determine the winner. The contestant with the most votes at the end of the collection period will be crowned the winner. If there are more than one participant in each category, the contestants will be crowned in royal hierarchy. (King, prince, court. Queen, princess, court)

**Age Requirements:** Contestants must be aged 13-19 years old and in school up to graduating seniors.

**Vote Tabulation:** Contestants will be required to turn their money into Community State Bank. Our treasurer, Tara Norris, will be able to track the deposits for each contestant. Winners will be announced at the date and time listed on the festival flyer. **CONTESTANTS ARE REQUIRED TO WEAR FORMAL ATTIRE ON CROWNING NIGHT.**

An entry fee of \$25.00 will be due when this signed agreement is turned into the event coordinator. This fee covers the cost of the crown and sash, as well as the committee shirt. The entry fee is nonrefundable.

If the contestant is unable to continue the contest, all funds raised must be turned into the treasurer, Tara Norris, at Community State Bank.

## **Duties, Responsibilities, and Expectations**

**Dress Code:** The contestant should be dressed appropriately while collecting donations. No short-shorts short skirts, torn jeans or inappropriate clothing. Contestants are encouraged to wear the t-shirt provided by the committee. **CONTESTANTS ARE REQUIRED TO WEAR FORMAL ATTIRE ON CROWNING NIGHT.**

**Attendance:** The contestants are required to attend the festival each day. Participation is mandatory. Please see a committee member in the brown building upon arrival for instructions.

Contestants are required to attend the crowning night.

Contestants are required to ride in the parade on the royalty float (or vehicle). The event coordinator and the parade director will collaborate with the contestant about the parade details. The parade details are:

The King and Queen are required to represent Wolf Lake Onion Days in the following events:

The King and Queen of this year's festival are required to crown the winners of the next contest (the following year).

**Expectations:** The Wolf Lake Onion Days Committee expects the contestants to refrain from public displays of affection (handholding is the exception). The manner of which the contestants conduct themselves should always be tasteful and respectful.
